3. Membership

Membership of 2GN is open to anyone who qualifies under our criteria (broadly, children, grandchildren and families of those affected by Nazi persecution). The 2GN also welcomes non-Members to many of our events.

When you apply to become a Member you agree to:

- provide accurate and honest information on your membership application;
- pay the annual membership fee (reduced rates are available — please see our website for details); and
- follow these Terms and Conditions and our Code of Conduct (see Section 6 below)

Membership runs for one year and must be renewed annually. The 2GN may cancel a membership if these Terms and Conditions are seriously or repeatedly broken.

4. The Members' Area

Members can access a private area of the website using a personal login (a username and password). You must:

- keep your login details private and not share them with anyone else;
- tell us immediately if you think someone else has used your account; and
- not try to access anyone else's account.

Content in the Members' Area — such as recordings of past events — is for Members only. Please do not copy, share or distribute this content without our permission.

5. Mailing List

If you sign up for our mailing list, we will send you emails about 2GN events and news. You can unsubscribe at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link in any email, or by writing to us at info@secondgeneration.org.uk. Please see our Privacy Policy for full details of how we handle your personal information.

6. Our Events and Workshops

We hold events online (via Zoom) and occasionally in person. When you attend a 2GN event or workshop, you agree to treat all other participants with respect and kindness, and to follow our Code of Conduct.

Some events are recorded. Where a recording is planned, we will tell you in advance. Recordings are made available on our website to Members only through the Members' Area.

The content on our website — including text, photographs, the magazine *Second Generation Voices*, and recordings of events — belongs to 2GN or to the individual contributors who created it. You may not copy, reproduce or share this content without our written permission, except for your own personal use.
